

Vie Ferrate – Fixed Rope Routes in Kleinwalsertal



Erlebnissteig Kanzelwand - *Adventure Climb Kanzelwand* – for beginners!

Fixed rope route on Kanzelwand. Aimed at beginners in the sport with climbing equipment, surefootedness and not afraid of heights. Highlight is the 26m Burma Bridge.
Family adventure: also suitable for kids from the age of 8 years old.

Route: Kanzelwand Mountain station 1949 m • Hiking trail direction Kanzelwand peak • Entry is signposted

Restaurants/Huts: Panorama Restaurant Kanzelwand

Walsertbus to Kanzelwand Gondola bottom station (ride up with the gondola)

Altitude Difference: 80 m

Duration: 1.5 hrs.

Length: 250 m

Difficulty Level: B

2-Länder-Sportklettersteig - *2 Country* –Fixed rope route – Physical and Difficult

Fixed rope route on Kanzelwand. This is only for extremely surefooted and experienced alpine mountaineers with climbing equipment, otherwise only with a mountain guide. Built in 2007 the route is a welcome challenge for the experienced climber and mountaineer alike. It covers a length of 500m in an inclined wall with steep & challenging upswings and traverses with breath taking views downwards. It challenges climbers with rope walks and difficult climbing passages that require conditioning as well as the right technique.

Route: Kanzelwand Mountain station 1949 m • Hiking trail direction the bottom station of the 2 country lift. •

Further on direction Fiderpass-Hut, approx. 10 Min from the bottom station • Entry is signposted

Restaurants/Huts: Panorama Restaurant Kanzelwand

Walsertbus to Kanzelwand Gondola bottom station (ride up with the gondola)

Altitude Difference: approx. 200 m

Duration: 3.5 hrs.

Length: 500 m

Difficulty Level: C – D

Mindelheimer Fixed Rope Route – The classic!!

The route is counted amongst the most interesting line walks in the Alps. The route goes through jagged Dolomia Principale and showcases ever changing and impressive rock formations. The crossing covers four peaks – the three Schafalpköpfe (2320, 2302, 2272 m) and the Kemptner Köpfe (2191m). We recommend this tour as a two day tour. Overnight accommodation is available on the Mindelheimer and Fiderpass huts. The route is kitted out with steel ropes, clamps and nails and is suitable for experienced, surefooted mountain climbers without a fear of heights. It was opened in 1975 and overhauled in 2007. German Alpine Association, Memmingen Section.

Route: Kanzelwand Mountain Station • Kühgund Alp • Fiderpass-Hut: approx. 2 hrs. / Fiderpass-Hut •

Mindelheimer fixed rope route • Mindelheimer Hut: approx. 3.5 hrs. / Mindelheimer Hut • Riezlern: approx. 3 hrs, to Mittelberg approx. 2.5 hrs.

Restaurants/Huts: Panorama Restaurant Kanzelwand, Fiderpass-Hut, Mindelheimer Hut, in Wildental

Walsertbus to Kanzelwand Gondola bottom station (ride up with the gondola), Line 1 und 4 to Schwendle or Höfle when entering over Wildental.

Altitude Difference: approx. 1050 m

Duration: approx. 8 hrs.

Length: 2.5 km

Difficulty Level: B - C

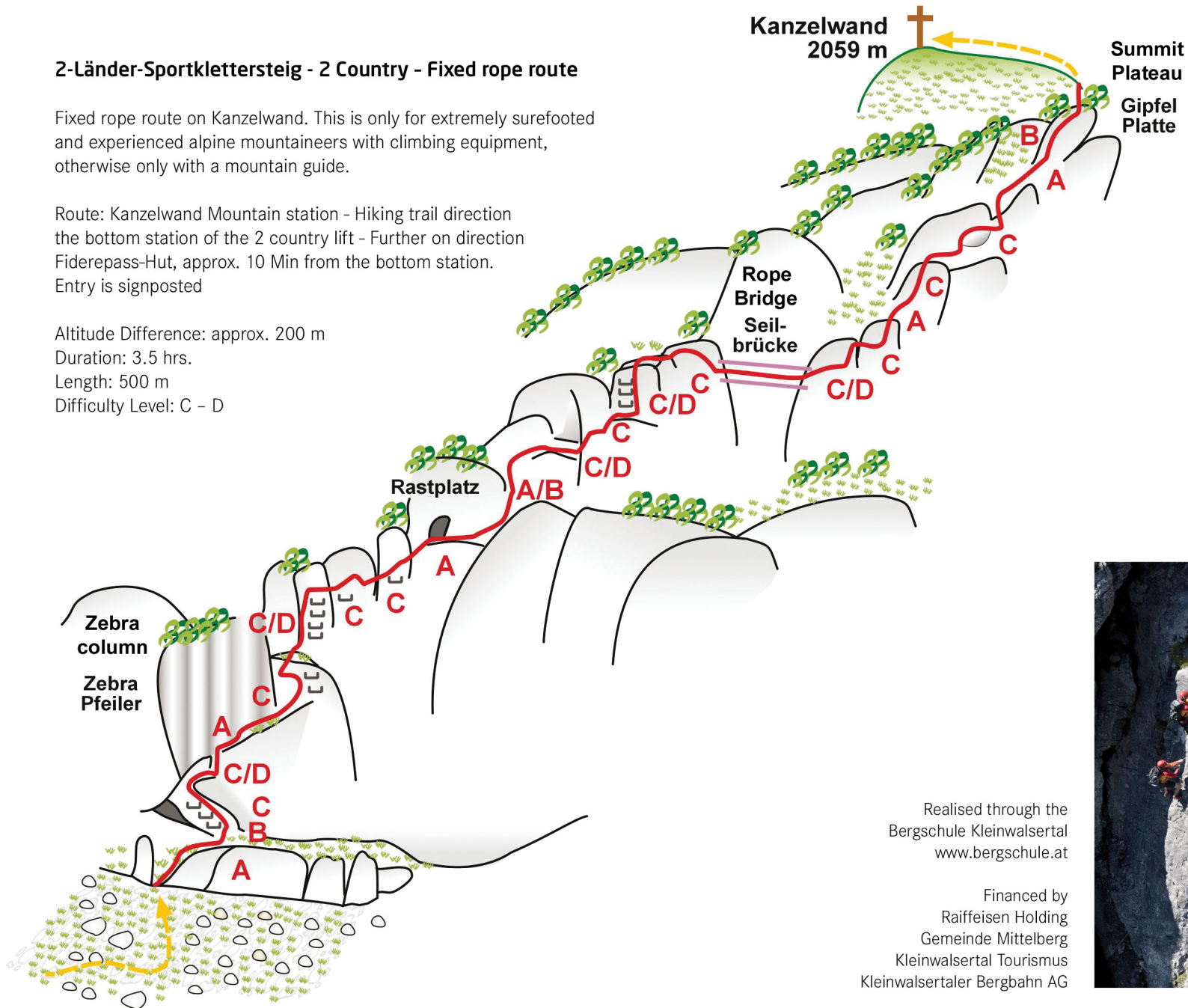

2-Länder-Sportklettersteig - 2 Country - Fixed rope route

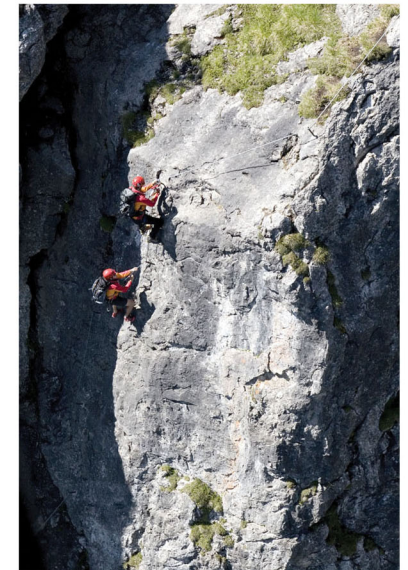

Route: Kanzelwand Mountain station - Hiking trail direction the bottom station of the 2 country lift - Further on direction Fiderepass-Hut, approx. 10 Min from the bottom station.
Entry is signposted

Altitude Difference: approx. 200 m
Duration: 3.5 hrs.
Length: 500 m
Difficulty Level: C - D
